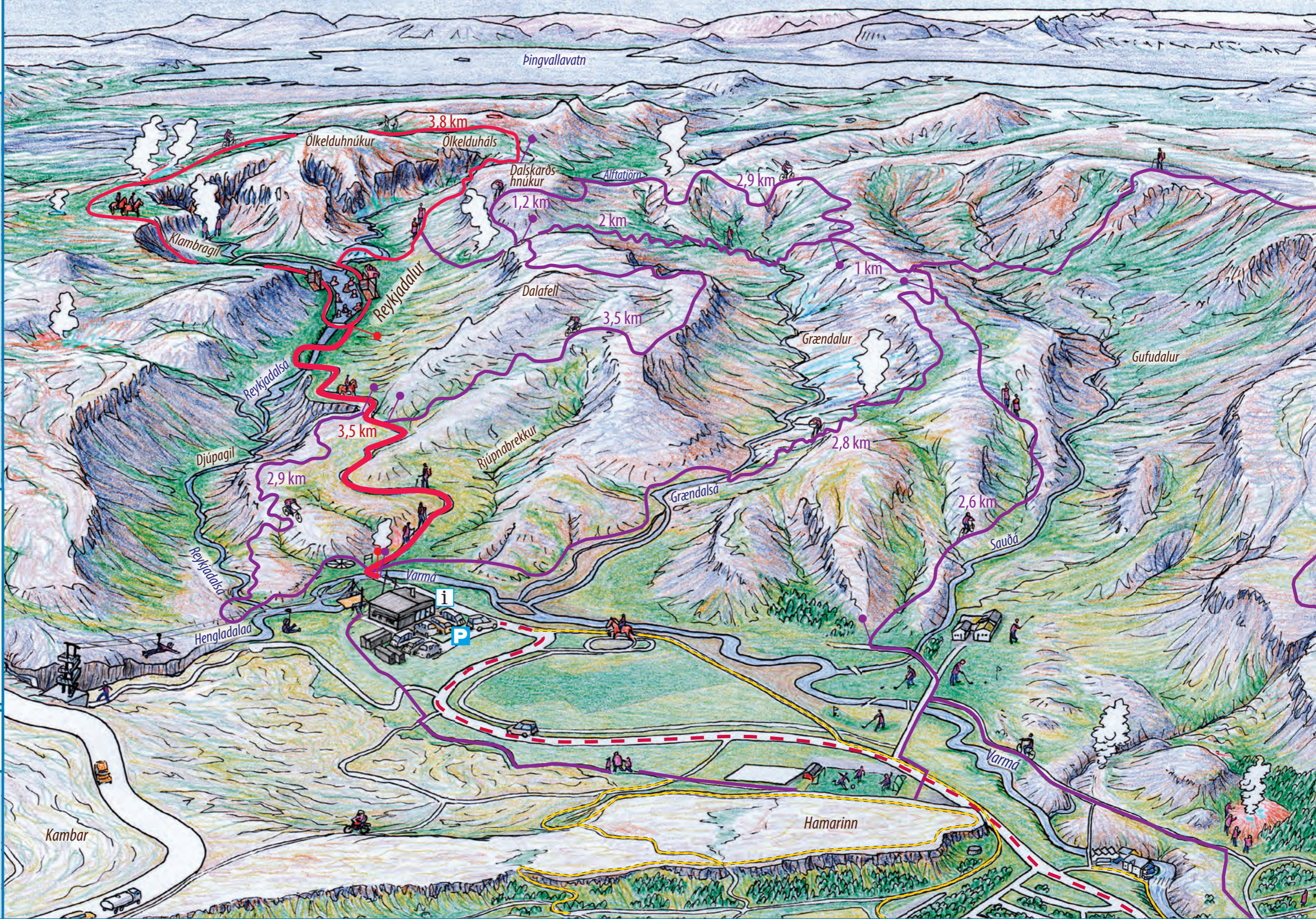

LOOKING FOR THE HOT RIVER?

Follow the main street (Breiðamörk) straight through town. Turn left at the sports center and drive all the way to the end of the road where you will find a parking area. Park your car cross the bridge and there you will find signs with information on different hiking trails. It is a 3.5 km hike to the hot river and the trail is marked with red and yellow poles. The hike to the river takes about an hour.

We ask you to take care of our nature by staying on the marked trails in the valley.
